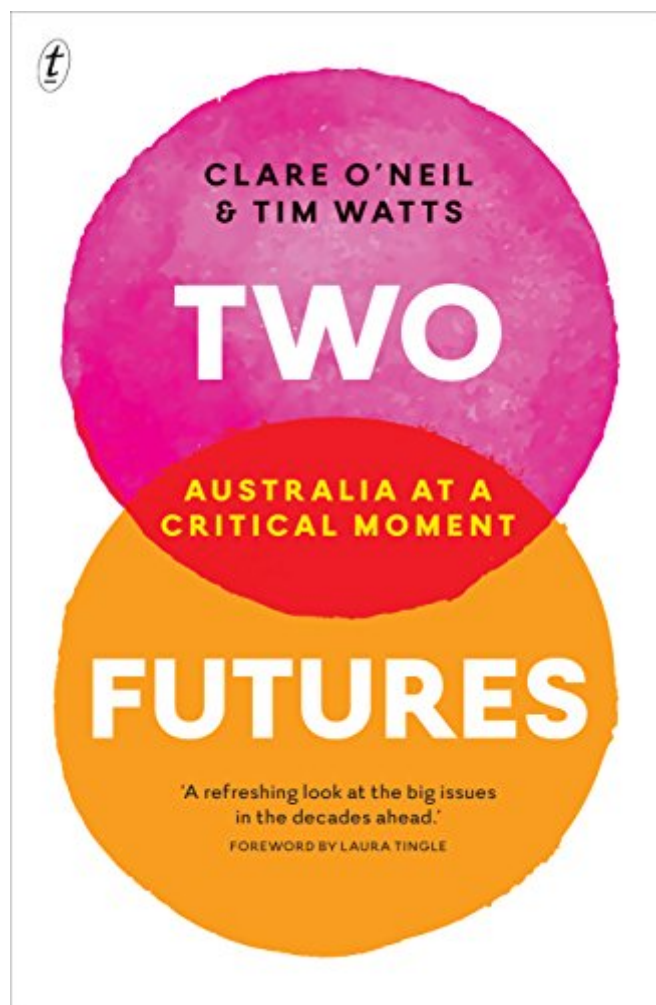

Two Futures: Australia at a Critical Momentby Clare Oâ™Neil & Tim WattsClare Oâ™Neil and Tim Watts, ALP MPs for Hotham and Gellibrand since 2013, take the long view of Australia to 2040 in âœTwo Futuresâ • aiming to change our nation. Unfortunately they must be unaware of Gough Whitlamâ™s old quote of âœnot unsettling the horses â |â •.Despite the title, the book does not offer âœtwo futuresâ • only a discussion with optimistic (good) and pessimistic (bad) extremes. The year 2040 is claimed to be âœa manageable timeframeâ • although the discussion is equally consistent for any year from 2020 or even earlier. No evidence is provided that âœAustralia [is] at a critical momentâ • except that politicians love to describe â^nowâ™ as a crisis. There is the usual complaints about the media (âœâ | leading to an increase in fanaticismâ •), communications technology (encouraging a âœneat sound grabâ • rather than policy) and that âœour democracy is in troubleâ •. Inequality, tax, education, role of unions, Indigenous Australians, the Digital Revolution or digital disruption (meaning communications & online data âœInstead of embracing the Digital Revolution, Australia resisted itâ •), climate change from greenhouse gases (which they strangely refuse to name except by the general word âœpollutionâ •), economic growth, and Australiaâ™s place in the world. On our democracy, the authors advocate:â ¢ A new institution, in fact many new institutions, within the ALP being the Online Policy Action Caucus (OPAC). Any ALP member could establish an OPAC, or an online group of 50 ALP members, that advocate on specific issues without organizational approval.
