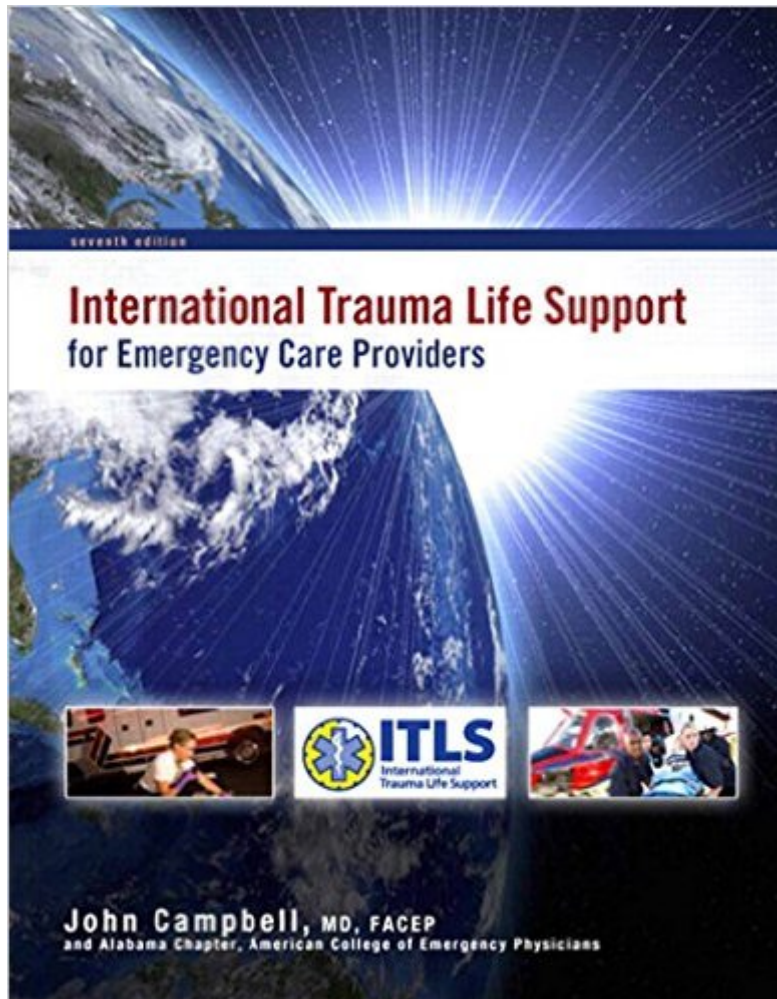

Actually it's very hard for me to post fair review on this book. I already own 6th edition which is excellent source of quick and helpful advises how to deal with various types of trauma from simple wounds to complicated neurological cases. So why only 3 stars? Don't get me wrong but 7th edition
