

I just read "Hey, Who's in My House?" and I loved it. It is a great addition to my book collection that I read with students who are experiencing divorce and remarriage in their families. I especially appreciated the candor from the authors and found it to be a refreshing take on the ups and downs of being in a blended family. Erin Mantz's story, "Fractions of Myself, Divided by Me, " especially spoke to me about the transitory and often complicated experience of finding family in many places. As an elementary school counselor, I plan on reading from this book with my support group for students whose parents are divorced.

Coming to terms with the destruction of oneâ™s own family and then being thrust into a whole new family situation can break anyoneâ™s spirit at the beginning and for some can take a lifetime to adjust. No one to blame if love can underlie all the unknowns--but knowledge of the hidden emotions and feelings certainly can help the situation.
