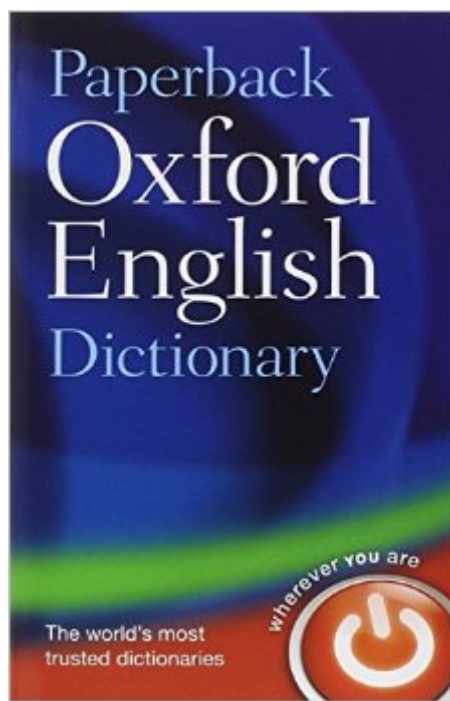


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This is a terrible book. Almost no pronunciations to be seen.

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
